

## Intensive German language course in Innsbruck

### Course

Every summer, Jesuits have the possibility of taking an intensive German language course in Innsbruck, Austria. In classes of approximately 15 participants you can learn German on all language levels. Classes take place Monday through Friday morning. In the afternoons, you have time to discover Innsbruck and its surroundings by yourself or take part in one of the activities offered through the program.

### Accommodation

While you have to pay for the language course itself, as Jesuit College, we offer free board and lodging for Jesuits for the duration of the course. The College is located in the centre of Innsbruck, in walking distance from the old town and the University of Innsbruck. We are also happy to help you with your visa (e.g. invitation letter for obtaining a Schengen Visa,...).

### Application process

If you are interested in taking the German language course in Innsbruck, please proceed in the following way:

- First, contact Mrs. Marianne Rosner-Schlenck at the Jesuit College via [sekretariat-jesuitenkolleg@jesuiten.org](mailto:sekretariat-jesuitenkolleg@jesuiten.org) – We will send you further information as well as our form for language course participants to fill in and return to us. We will also check if there is still a room available for you, as we have limited capacities in our house. If you are accepted, we will reserve a room for you.
- After receiving the “ok” from the Jesuit College, contact the Sprachenzentrum (language centre) of the University of Innsbruck via [sprachenzentrum@uibk.ac.at](mailto:sprachenzentrum@uibk.ac.at) – They will inform you how to register and pay for the language course.
- Get informed about the visa requirements and insurance needs for your stay in Innsbruck. If you need any help with this (e.g. invitation letter for obtaining a Schengen Visa, travel insurance for the duration of your stay,...), let us know, we are happy to help.
- Book your plane/train/bus/... ticket to Innsbruck and let us know your exact date and time of arrival and departure so we can get everything ready for you in time.
